



### **'To the End of Hell' Donation Form**

Part of the profits from the sale of *To the End of Hell* will be given to the Documentation Center of Cambodia (DC-Cam), where a scholarship has been set up in the name of Denise Affonco's nine-year old daughter, Jeannie, who starved to death under the Khmer Rouge regime.

DC-Cam is an independent research institute that provides a crucial source of information about the tragic period in Cambodian history for academics, lawyers, activists and the general public.

DC-Cam has two main objectives. Firstly, to record and preserve the history of the Khmer Rouge regime for future generations. Secondly, to compile and organise information that can serve as potential evidence in any forthcoming trials of members of the Khmer Rouge. It believes that memory and justice are the foundations for the rule of law and genuine national reconciliation in Cambodia.
